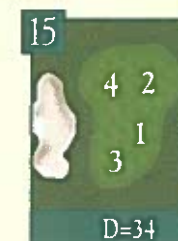

USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE LOCAL RULES PREVAIL

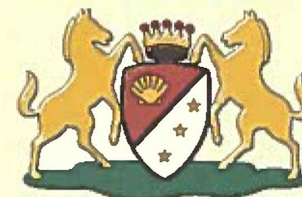
- Hole 5: For balls in either the water hazard or the lateral water hazard, an option of using the ball drop located on the tee side is available, under Rule 26-1.
- In the absence of white stakes or perimeter fence posts, all roads bordering the golf course define out-of-bounds. In addition, the cart path on the right side of hole 18 is to be played as a road, and any ball coming to rest on or to the right of the cart path is considered out of bounds.
- If a ball comes to rest in citrus orchard and the players' swing or stance is interfered with by the citrus orchard, the ball must be dropped, without penalty, under Rule 25-1.
- Embedded Ball — "Through the green," a ball that is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground, other than sand, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay but no nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green. Exception: A player may not take relief under this Local Rule if it is clearly unreasonable for him to play a stroke because of interference by anything other than the condition covered by this rule.
- Stones in Bunkers — Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. (Rule 24-1 applies)
- All Water hazards are to be played as Lateral water hazards, and hazard lines are defined by red stakes or lines.
- Yardage on sprinkler heads indicate distances to middle of green.
- Please keep carts on paths around tees and greens, and drive no nearer than 60 feet from edge of green.
- Please register before teeing off.
- Cards are to be dated, signed, attested and showing tees played.
- Post your score and leave your card in the drop box.
- Course uses recycled water.
